Rome, 4th Julii, 1770

I have nothing to write to you about, except that my leg, praise God, is fine. On the other hand, I have a little rheumatism in the left shoulder. We will, at the latest, travel in 8 or 10 days to Bologna over Loreto.² Just a moment ago, [5] one of Cardinal Pallavicini's³ servants was here to say we should come to His Eminence tomorrow at midday, and on Friday we dine with His Excellency the Tuscan Ambassador, esteemed Baron Saint-Odile.⁴ Tomorrow we are to hear news which, if it is true, will leave you astonished. It is said, indeed, that Cardinal Pallavicini has received a command from the Pope to present Wolfgang with a Cross of the Order and a diploma.⁵ [10] I am not yet saying much about it. Is it true? – I will therefore write to you on the coming Saturday. The last time we were at the Cardinal's home, he said "Sigre Cavaliere" several times to Wolfgang. We thought it was just a joke. Now I hear that it is true, and that that is the reason why we are invited tomorrow. Today we dined at Sgr. Crivelli's, who treated us wonderfully. He asks us to pass on his compliments. [15] Give my compliments to the esteemed Canon de Chiusolis, 8 he had also passed on his compliments to me via Herr Crivelli. Addio. Keep well. I must hurry, for the post is leaving. Wolfgang cannot write, he is writing to Bologna, to the son of Field Marshal Pallavicini. We kiss you 1000 times.
