Herr *Marcobruni*¹ commends himself, he is here with me, and at this moment we will go to the theatre, for on the 16th there was the *opera*² and on the 17th the *Serenata*,³ [5] which was received so astonishingly well that they have to *repeat* it today. The Archduke⁴ recently ordered 2 *copies*. All *noble gentlemen*⁵ and other people speak to us continually on the street to *congratulate* Wolfgang. In short, <u>I feel sorry</u> that Wolfgang's *serenade* has vanquished *Hasse's*⁶ *opera* so thoroughly that I cannot describe it. Your last letter⁷ and Nannerl's *postscriptum* will have my answer with the next post. [10] You will see⁸ Italy with greater pleasure than would be the case now amid this abominable noise. *Addio*. We kiss both of you many 10000 times. I am as always your
