Today, 3rd September of the same year, I was so unfortunate as to lose, entirely unexpectedly, this Noble Man, dearest and best Friend and Saviour of my Life. – All is well for him! – but for me – us – [5] and all who knew him well, – but for us all will <u>never</u> be well again – until we are so fortunate as to see him in a better world – once more – and <u>never to part again</u>.

DME: Dr. Sigmund Barisani (* 1758) died on 3rd September, 1787. He made an entry in the album on 14th April, 1787 (cf. Deutsch Dok p. 255). Sigmund Barisani was the younger son of the Salzburg Archbishop's personal physician, Dr. Silvester Barisani; he treated Mozart in 1784 for influenza and in 1784 for renal colic. His brother, Dr. Joseph Barisani (1756-1826) treated Leopold Mozart in Salzburg.
