1384. GEORGE NIKOLAUS NISSEN TO CARL THOMAS, 1 MILAN

Vienna, on the 11th Oct., 1809 EXCERPT:

. . . Two days ago, Don Juan² was performed in German in the theatre at Schönbrunn Palace in the presence of his Majesty the French Emperor³...

¹ BD: Mozart's second child, Carl Thomas, was born on 21st September, 1784. He was the longest-lived member of the family, dying in Milan on 31st October, 1858. Grammar school in Vienna; mercantile employment in Livorno approx. 1800-1805, after which he moved to Milan. Started musical studies, but ultimately kept music as a hobby and became a civil servant.

³ BD: The "French Emperor" was Napoleon Bonaparte I, who had occupied Vienna for the second time on 13th May, 1809. Three days after Nissen had sent off this letter, the Treaty of Schönbrunn was agreed.
