0107.¹ LEOPOLD MOZART TO LORENZ HAGENAUER,² SALZBURG

[Paris, May, 1766]

... Although all official performances were strictly forbidden during our time in *Amsterdam* because of Lent, we did receive permission to give a *concert*.³ This was, as the wording of the pious and circumspect resolution put it, [5] because the dissemination of these miraculous gifts was of service in the praise of God. Nor was anything presented except Wolfgang's own instrumental music...
